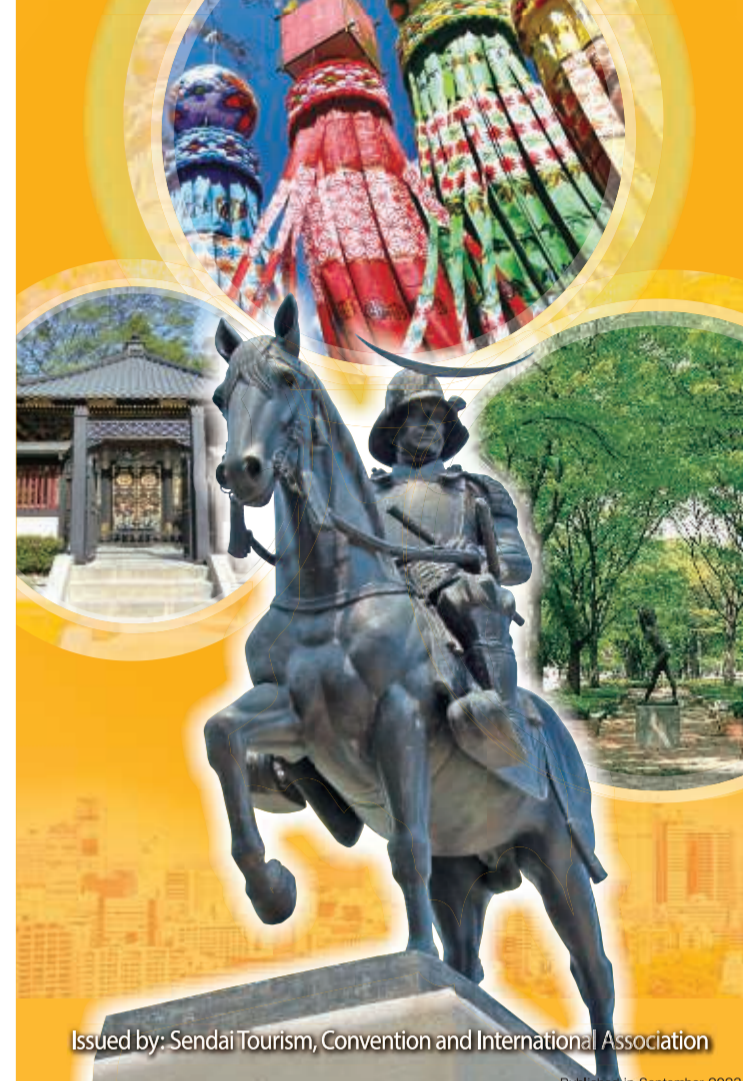

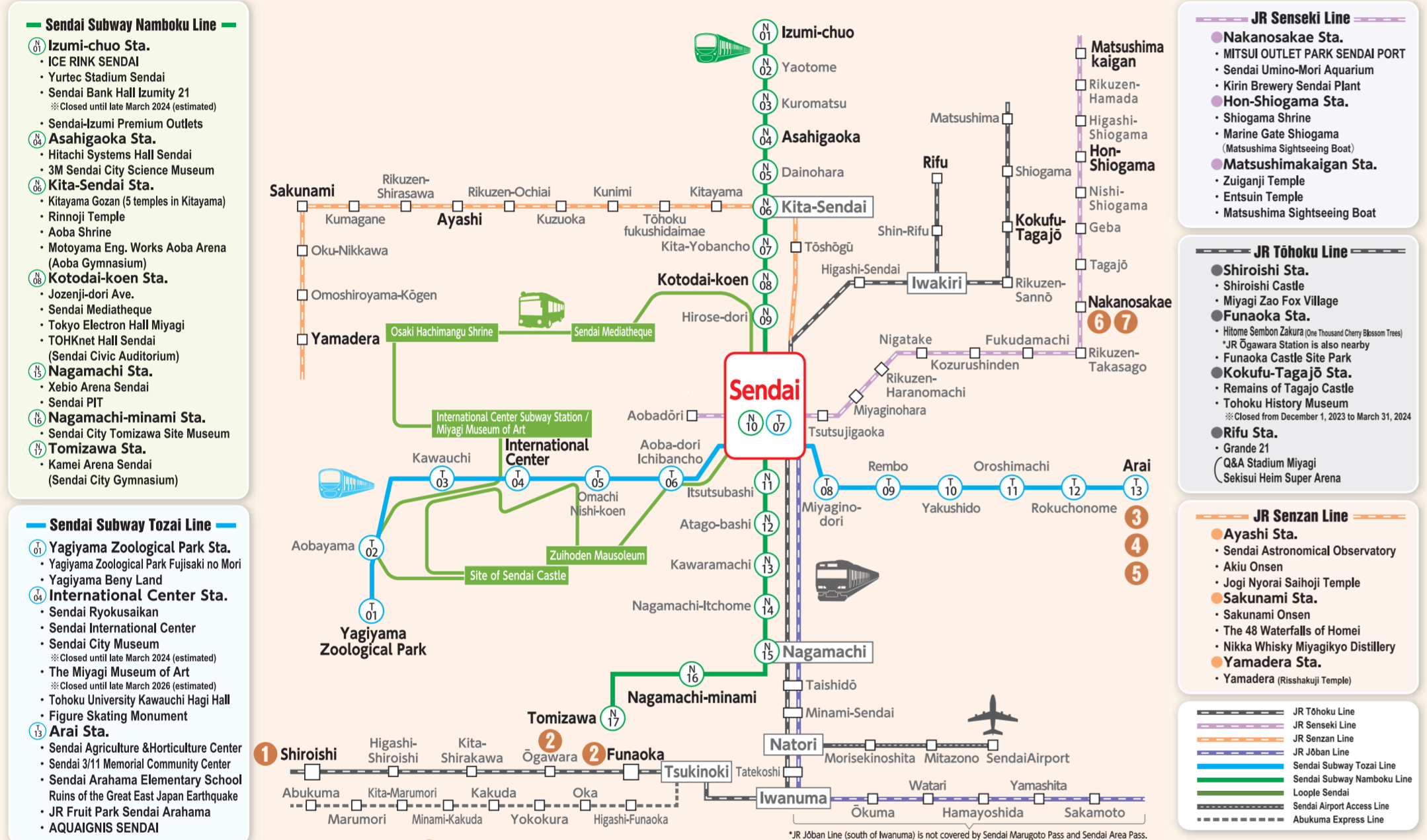

## Travelling in and around Sendai on a budget? Check these out!

### Unlimited use passes for the areas shown above (except for the JR Joban Line)!

The following passes offer unlimited rides on JR lines between Sendai, Matsushima, Matsushimakaigan, Yamadera, and Shirosai Stations; Sendai Airport Access Line; Loope Sendai buses; all Sendai City buses (excluding the Rakuten Shuttle Bus); both Sendai Subway Lines; Miyagi Kotsu Bus between Sendai and Akiu Otaki; and the Abukuma Express Line between Tsukinoki and Abukuma Stations. Excludes JR Joban Line between Iwanuma and Sakamoto

- **One-Day Pass--"SENDAI AREA PASS"** Adults: ¥1,320 Children: ¥660
- **Two-Day Pass--"THE SENDAI MARUGOTO PASS"** Adults: ¥2,720 Children: ¥1,350

You can get buses along about 100 local and expressway routes covering the six prefectures in the Tohoku region as many times as you like during the designated period.

Enjoy sightseeing by rental car! ● **Tohoku Expressway Pass**

The Tohoku Expressway Pass is a special service that allows unlimited use of Tohoku expressways through the ETC system at a flat rate!
